PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

Two story Red Stretcher or Running Bond Brick front facade distinguished by two first story picture windows with a plain lug sill and topped by stained glass. Second story is four bays of Double Hung (1/1 lights) windows with a continuous sill and plain stone lintel. Front entrance (111) aligned at the left and angled inward at a diagonal. Front entrance (113) aligned at the right. Small pediment above left entrance. Brick foundation with no water table. Side and rear facades are of brown brick and feature Stilted Arch Double Hung windows and Awning windows. Rectangular in plan, except for left diagonal front entrance. Shed roof with parapets along the side roof lines. The name, Courier, is inscribed in a stone tablet above the left front entrance. Side entrance opens onto the public alleyway.

Vernacular style since there are no predominant architectural elements; the building lacks decorative detailing.
